# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Do I need Council Approval?

Development Applicants – separate approval to remove a tree may not be necessary – contact our Customer Service Centre to clarify before completing this form.

You **do NOT** need Council approval to remove or prune a tree if the tree is:

- No higher than 3m and has a girth of no more than 300mm at a height of Im above the ground.
- In Council's opinion, is dying or dead or has become dangerous.
- A species declared to be a noxious weed under the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 or fruit plants identified in Schedule 1 to the Plant Diseases Act 1924.
- A species exempted from Council's Tree Preservation Order.

Otherwise - YES - you do need approval!

#### Where do I send my application and payment?

You can pay in person at Council's Customer Service Centre – 2 Bryant Street, Rockdale or you can post your application and a cheque or money order to Rockdale City Council, PO Box 21, ROCKDALE NSW 2216.

## Do I have the right to appeal against a decision made by the Tree Management Officer?

If you are not satisfied with the decision of the Tree Management Officer, you may request that Council's Manager of Operations review this decision. If you are still not satisfied you can request that your application be put to a Council meeting for determination.

You may also elect at any time to have the matter heard before the Land and Environment Court if you are dissatisfied with the way Council has dealt with your application.

## What are my options if I want to prune a tree on my neighbour's property?

If the neighbour's tree overhangs your property and if those branches have a girth of 200mm or less (63.7mm / 2.5 inches in diameter) at your boundary you do not need Council's permission to prune of trim the branches. Pruning must occur on your side of the boundary only.

This does not apply to trees that are heritage items, are in the vicinity of heritage items or are within heritage conservation areas. Pruning of these trees requires the approval of Council.

It is not the role of Council to intervene in neighbourhood disputes regarding trees. Conflicts may be resolved through the Community Justice Centre.
